## **Refraction and Copay Policy**

(Medicare and Medicare Advantage patients)

**Refraction / Prescription for new glasses**: Please note that due to Medicare's policy, your Medical insurance **will not** pay for a prescription for new glasses for any reason. If you wish to have a Refraction / Prescription for new glasses at the time of your exam the fee is \$25.00 payable on the day of service.

\*Medicaid supplement to Medicare and some BCBS primary policies are the only exceptions.

If you have <u>Vision Insurance</u> and wish to have a routine, complete exam for new glasses and / or contact lenses we will gladly schedule you an appointment with Dr. Debra Denton O.D. our staff Optometrist who participates with most vision insurance plans.

<u>Copay / Deductibles:</u> Many insurance companies apply copays and deductibles. Please be advised that all insurance copays and known deductibles are payable on the date of service. We reserve the right to request payment prior to your appointment. Thank you.
